Understanding of the role of intermodal facilities for the research objective

Understanding of the socio-economic impact which the road to rail objective		
seeks to achieve;		
Knowledge and understanding of the SA development agenda e.g. NDP,		
IPAP etc.		
Research team (Principal supported by the team of qualified and experienced	15%	
individuals who will be working on the research, they should all be available as		
per the project proposal throughout the project)		
Implementation Approach	20%	
Clear and detailed research methodology (clearly articulating the		
complementary role of road and rail mode;		
Set guidelines and project deliverables;		
Prepare Inception Report to outline project modus operandi and		
projected outcomes;		
Project outcomes to be clearly set out from the onset;		
Set project schedule/calendar;		
Detailed implementation plan, with timeframes.		
Masters in a field associated to the research project (PhD in the field will have	10%	
added advantage)		
On a weighting of 100% service provider must obtain 70% and above to be considered
